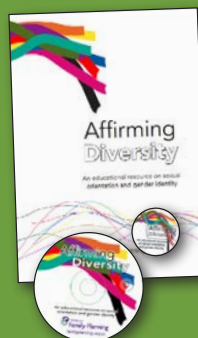


The Colours of Sexuality
